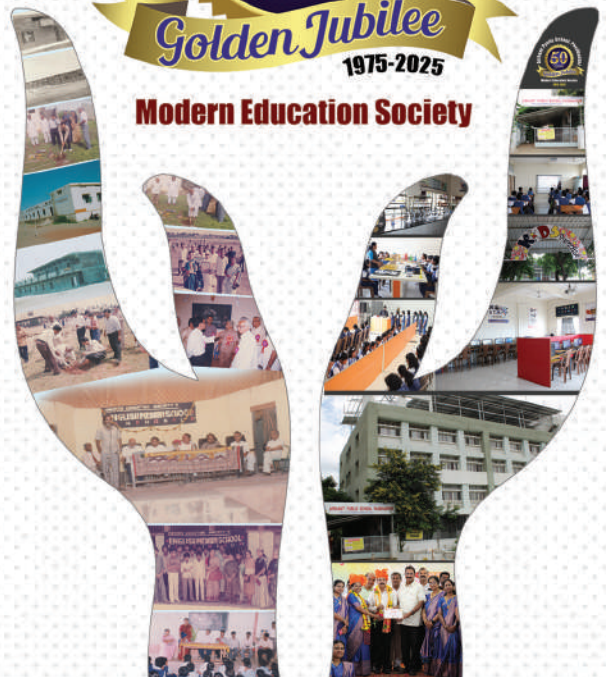

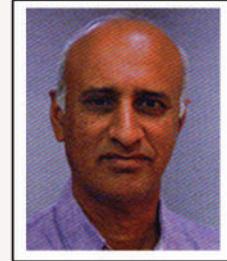

DECLARATION

- Information provided in this handbook is governed by the policies of Modern Education Society & Arihant Public School.
- Before raising any query, parents are requested to go through the Hand Book thoroughly. This will help to resolve many queries automatically.
- The dates of the exam/events/celebration may change depending upon the prevailing situation.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS AND STUDENTS माता-पिता और छात्रों के लिए दिशानिर्देश

» Attendance and Punctuality (उपस्थिति और समय की पाबंदी)

- 1) Punctuality and regular attendance are essential.
- 2) Parents are expected to inform the teacher about illness.
- 3) In case of illness, a Medical Certificate must be submitted.
- 4) Students expecting to reach home late due to personal reasons must inform their parents/guardians in advance.

» School Timings (स्कूल का समय)

- 1) Entry into the school premises is not permitted before 8.00 a.m.
- 2) Students are expected to be present 5 minutes before Assembly.
- 3) Strict action will be taken against Habitual late comers.
- 4) Parents will not argue on the discipline policy of the school.
- 5) A minimum of 75% attendance is mandatory to be eligible for examinations.

» Dress Code and Personal Hygiene (ड्रेस कोड और व्यक्तिगत स्वच्छता)

- 1) Students must wear a clean, neatly ironed uniform with polished shoes.
- 2) Faded colour uniforms are not allowed.
- 3) Students will wear Sports Uniforms on all the Sports and MPT Periods.
- 4) Hair must be trimmed, and nails should be regularly cut.
- 5) Girls with long hair must wear plaits. White hair band is compulsory for all the girl students. Fancy hair accessories are not allowed.

» General Conduct (सामान्य आचरण)

- 1) Respect for school property and belongings is mandatory.
- 2) In cases of collective damage to classroom property, the entire class will bear the cost of repairs.
- 3) Students should help maintain cleanliness by disposing of waste in dustbins.
- 4) Students must wear the school identity card every day.
- 5) Students should bring only the books required as per the timetable.

» Movement and Discipline (अनुशासन)

- 1) While moving between classes, students should keep to the left in corridors and staircases, ensuring no disturbance to others.
- 2) Courteous and polite language must be used at all times.
- 3) Students will not go out of the campus for any reason without the prior intimation of the school authorities.

» Prohibited Items (निषिद्ध वस्तुएँ)

- Accessories: Ornaments, Jewellery, Tattoos etc.
- Restricted Materials: Objectionable literature, expensive items or obscene materials.
- Electronics: Cell phones, iPods, CDs, DVDs, e-games, pen drives, cameras, music players.
- Dangerous Items: Crackers, fireworks, firearms or any other inflammable materials.
- Unapproved Gifts: Gifts for distribution, including birthday celebrations.
- Other Items: Toys, dangerous instruments (e.g., e-cigarettes), tobacco products, alcoholic drinks, chewing gum and banned food items.

» Library Rules and Regulations (पुस्तकालय नियम और विनियम)

- 1) All students of the school are the members of the library.
- 2) Strict discipline and silence must be maintained in the library.
- 3) Library books should be handled with care and returned on or before the due date.
- 4) Marking, underlining, writing or damaging pages of books is strictly prohibited.

» Library Fine Policy (पुस्तकालय जुर्माना नीति)

- 1) Late Return: A fine of Rs. 5/- per day will be charged after 7 days of the due date.
- 2) Loss of Book: The book must either be replaced with the same title or the current cost of the book must be paid.

» Medical Emergencies (चिकित्सा आपातस्थिति)

- We prioritize your child's safety through close supervision and maintaining safe, child-friendly facilities. However, minor scratches and bumps can occur as young children are energetic and still developing control over their movements.
- Appropriate first aid will be administered in case of minor injuries. For any injury or illness requiring professional medical attention, you will be contacted immediately. It is vital that you respond promptly to all school phone calls.

» Birthday Celebrations (जन्मदिन का जश्न)

- We encourage parents to celebrate birthdays modestly at school. Students can wear decent civil dress on his/her birthday. One eggless cake may be sent or brought during Tiffin Break. The cake will be cut during snack time and shared with classmates. However, gifts, chocolates or candies are not permitted to be distributed.
- Gifts to the teachers and staff members is strictly prohibited.

» Fee Payment Procedures (शुल्क भुगतान प्रक्रिया)

- Parents are required to clear the academic fees in the given schedule. Additional 10 days grace period will be given as a chance to pay the fees.
- In case of failure to meet the payment schedule, appropriate penalty will be imposed by the school.
- In case of non-payment of fees before start of the examination, school reserves the right to prohibit the student to allow for examination.
- Installment Schedule (किस्त अनुसूची)
- Before Start of the Academic Year.
- Before end of Diwali Vacations.

» Examinations (परीक्षाएं)

- Students should compulsorily attend all the school examinations including oral and written examinations.
- In case of medical emergency, sports competitions if the student remain absent, average marks will be awarded to the students.
- Examinations will not be taken again in any cost.
